

PROFESSIONAL MASTER'S FAMILY NURSING



The Professional Master's Programme in Family Nursing aims to prepare qualified nursing staff for the prevention and management of diseases and for patient rehabilitation, both in Primary Health Care (PHC) centres and in home-based care settings. The programme responds to the growing demand for specialised home care services, driven by population ageing and the increasing prevalence of chronic diseases.

HAP's Contribution:

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 Provided technical expertise to the multidisciplinary working group composed of representatives from the University of Medicine, the Faculty of Technical Medical Sciences (FTMS), the Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, the Order of Physicians, the Order of Nurses, and Primary Health Care providers to support the development of a modern curriculum.
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 Strengthened the capacities of academic staff by supporting lecturers with reference literature, training delivered by national and international experts, and study visits to international educational institutions.

 Improved teaching infrastructure through the establishment of a Clinical Practice Simulation Laboratory at the Faculty of Technical Medical Sciences (FTMS), supporting the development of students' practical clinical skills.
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 Contributed to the student learning process by supporting the development of textbooks and their distribution to students free of charge at the beginning of each academic year.

 Prepared clinical mentors by training internship supervisors and nursing teams in health centres to guide students in developing practical competencies.
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 Improved the practical training environment by upgrading the infrastructure of several Primary Health Care centres where student internships take place.
